Dear Weekapaug Yacht Club members,

I'm happy to announce that the 2017 Weekapaug Yacht Club online sailing and membership registration is now officially open.

Please note that registration forms are only accepted through online submission. To register for summer 2017 sailing classes and/or kiddie camp and to pay membership dues, please visit <http://www.weekapaugyachtclub.com>. The Weekapaug Yacht Club offers sailing classes over the course of two one-month-long sessions in July and August (with the exception of the Adventures class, which is offered in two-week increments). The 2017 summer schedule is as follows:

July session dates: Beginning Monday, July 3 and ending Friday, July 28. The July Awards Dinner will be held on Saturday, July 29.

August session dates: Beginning Monday, July 31 and ending Friday, August 25. The August Awards Dinner will be held on Saturday, August 26.

We are excited to introduce a new class this summer. Paddle Boarding has been added to our curriculum and will be available as a monthly or full season class. This new course is a great way to learn the popular sport of stand up paddle boarding--the perfect blend of exercise and fun. Paddle boarding builds core body strength, is low impact, and most importantly, will get you out on beautiful Quonochontaug Pond.

Weekapaug Yacht Club's Board voted in March to increase our mooring and anchorage fees. Anchorage fees for 2017 have increased from \$6.50 to \$8.45 per foot for boats 14 feet and under and have increased from \$9.50 to \$12.35 per foot for boats over 14 feet. The monthly mooring fee has increased from \$150 to \$173. The Board's rationale in doing so was to support WYC's budgetary goals, while still keeping our mooring and anchorage costs inexpensive in comparison to other clubs.
